WHERE:

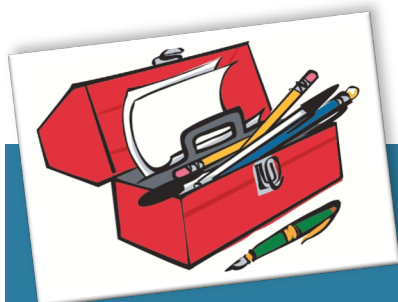
